Cultivating Global Competencies in Tomorrow's Leaders: A Teacher's Guide to Student Preparation

Legal Education in the 21st Century: Role of Law Teachers

Special attention will be given to the impact of the General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS) under the World Trade Organization (WTO) on legal education.
